Themes between April and June 2018

Theme	Issues arising	Actions by IPSO in response
Reporting of suicide	Publication of excessive detail about the method of suicide used	Guidance for journalists and editors on the reporting of suicide is planned. IPSO developed and delivered a training module for publishers on the reporting of suicide.
Victims of sexual assault	Complaint about potential identification of victim of sexual assault.	Guidance for journalists and editors will be published in 2018 and factors arising from this complaint will be fed into this guidance as appropriate.
Children	Publication of information which related to a child's welfare	On-going monitoring of complaints relating to this theme
Privacy in hospitals	Publication of video showing a UK resident receiving treatment in hospital overseas	On-going monitoring of complaints
Accuracy	Failure to take care to publish information accurately	These complaints highlight specific issues relating to the processes which publishers must follow in order to ensure accuracy. These issues will be monitored to ensure that there are not consistent failures in such processes.
